Since 2012, the Children's Services Council of Martin County has provided over 1,300 children with FREE entry-level swimming lessons and water safety skills classes.

Registration is open to Martin County children ages 6 months- 17 years who qualify for free or reduced cost lunch at school or Florida Kid Care (Medicaid).

According the Florida Department of Health, Florida loses more children under the age of 5 to drowning, then any other state. The SPLASH program helps children learn how to be safe in Martin County pools and waterways.
